




### Classroom Dollars

### District-reported 2003 results

#### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher and librarian earned an additional \$4,337 in salary.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on district performance.

- The goal not met required students to make adequate yearly progress based on standardized tests.
