





District-reported 2004 results

Teacher pay

- On average each teacher earned an additional \$3,900 in salary. Additionally, 3 teachers, an instructional aide, and 3 bus drivers earned monies for operating an AIMS intervention summer program. These teachers earned an extra \$2,000 and the aide and drivers earned between \$280 and \$495.

Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were linked to student achievement, teacher evaluations and professional development, and parent-student satisfaction.

Menu

- 44 students participated in a 4-week AIMS intervention summer program focused on improving reading, writing, and math scores.
- According to the District, more than 80 percent of all students who took the AIMS test improved their scores compared to last year.
- Each teacher participated in 8 hours of professional development relating to classroom discipline.
- Teachers also participated in training focused on phonics and writing.
