




Classroom Dollars

District-reported 2003 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,910 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- Teachers were required to align math, reading, and writing curriculums to state standards and assess students.

Menu

- A second kindergarten class was added, reducing class size from 30 students to 15.
- Physical education classes were added so that each class now serves 1 grade instead of 2.
