





District-reported 2004 results

Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,630 in salary, and the librarian, nurse, and staff development/curriculum coordinator each earned an additional \$1,875.

Performance

- The District accomplished some goals, which were based on school and individual performance.
- 2 teachers had perfect attendance.
- 3 teachers completed graduate-level courses and received a \$100 bonus per completed class as well as assistance with tuition, books, recertification, and fingerprint costs.
- Unmet goals were linked to increasing students' reading test scores and attendance.

Menu

- Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation.
