



Teacher

 On average, each teacher earned an additional \$2,916 in salary, and each instructional aide, librarian, and social worker earned between \$102 and \$999 in additional pay.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were based on school performance.
- At least 50 percent of students at 3 of the District's schools received passing scores on standardized tests.
- The District maintained a graduation rate of 71.5 percent and increased the attendance rate to 95 percent.

Menu

- Monies were used to pay for 2 counselors to work on dropout prevention.
- Monies were also used to pay 3 counselors to review transcripts and re-formulate high school class schedules.
- 4 staff development specialists were paid to work with teachers on improving instruction strategies, aligning curriculum with state standards, and math intervention programs.
- Monies were also used to pay for AIMS intervention tutors and classroom supplies.
