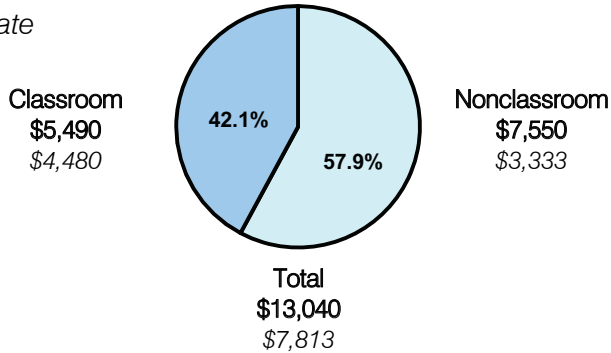

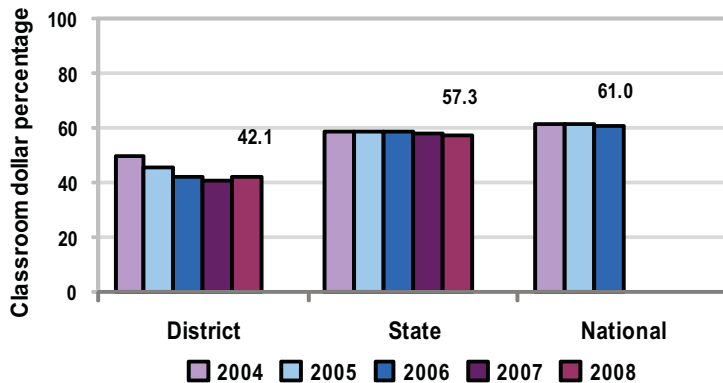

### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2008 results

##### Teacher pay

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$4,530 in salary, and each librarian earned \$3,992.

##### Performance

- The District accomplished some of its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district and school performance.
- Only 1 of 3 schools demonstrated Adequate Yearly Progress.
- Parents and students graded the District a "C" or better on a satisfaction survey.
- The District did not meet the goal of having at least 44 percent of its students on grade-level in reading, writing, and math.

##### Menu

- Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation.
