



Proposition 301 expenditures were 5.34 percent of the District's \$1,390,229 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$5,304 in compensation.
- All 14 teachers accomplished performance goals resulting in at least 80 percent of students demonstrating math, reading, and life skills through student work portfolios. Portfolios are used to measure achievement since 97 percent of the District's students are incarcerated, with average stays ranging from 14 days to 6 months.
- There was no teacher turnover during the year.
