



### Proposition 301

#### District-reported 2008 results

#### Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher earned an additional \$5,207 in salary, and each librarian and counselor earned an additional \$1,551.

#### Performance

- The District accomplished most of its goals, which were based on individual performance.
- Teachers received a "satisfactory" or higher on their performance evaluations.
- Teachers could receive additional performance pay if they took on additional responsibilities such as team leader or test coordinator.

Monies were used solely to increase eligible employee compensation, which the District indicates may be partially responsible for a 25 percent reduction in teacher turnover.
