



Proposition 301 expenditures were 1.15 percent of the District's \$621,840 current operating expenditures in fiscal year 2002.

#### District-reported 2002 results

- On average, each teacher earned an additional \$1,858 in salary.
- 3 teachers and 2 instructional aides accomplished performance goals involving such things as student scores on standardized tests; parent contacts; class enrollment; and identifying state standards in lesson plans for math, reading, and writing.
