



Teacher pay

 On average, each teacher and instructional aide earned an additional \$4,757 in salary, and the librarian earned an additional \$1,708.

Performance

- 100 percent of graduating seniors passed all 3 sections of the AIMS test.
- At least 65 percent of parents surveyed rated the District's overall performance as "good" or better.
