



Teacher pay

• On average, each teacher, instructional aide, the librarian, and a counselor earned an additional \$4,335 in salary.

Performance

- The District accomplished its goals, which were the same as the prior fiscal year's goals and were based on district performance.
- 100 percent of high school seniors passed all 3 sections of the AIMS test.
- 65 percent of parents surveyed rated the District's overall performance as "good" or better.
